

# EASING RESTRICTIONS FOR STUDENTS

## QLD ACTION PLAN

While Australians have been instructed to keep 1.5 metres apart, Mr Morrison said the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) had determined students did not need to abide by that advice in the classroom.

## FRIDAY 15 MAY - YOU CAN

- Visit public libraries, playground equipment, skate parks and outdoor gyms. (a maximum of 10 at one time)
- Gatherings of a maximum of 10 people together in a public space.
- Recreational travel of a radius of up to 150km from your home for day trips.
- Swim in public pools and lagoons. (a maximum of 10 at one time)

**15 MAY, 2020**

Decision on other other year levels returning to school.

**12 JUNE, 2020 (STAGE 2)**

Further opening of facilities and increased social getherings.
